STARTING IN THE WOMB—According to the Human Life Alliance group out of Minneapolis, every day in the United States, 3,315 babies are denied justice and executed with no judge, no jury, and no trial. If that's not unjust, I don't know what is. Since 1973, the United States has the blood of more than 51 million babies on its hands.

No country has more permissive abortion laws than the United States, where abortion is legal all nine months of pregnancy for any reason. Even if restrictions exist in one state, it is legal for a woman to travel to another state to obtain a late-term abortion.
