April 12, 2010 MINUTES SUMMARY**

Old Business: Automatic Defibrillator pricing was provided. Waiting to hear back from Hackensack on information we requested. Richard Bilger will be consulted with by Sandy Munson. Decision made to submit pricing to Finance Council.

Parish Council Elections—April 24th & 25th The four candidates; will be featured in the bulletin again on April 17th & 18th. Absentee ballots available in the office. Ballots will inform voters to vote for up to three people. The ushers will get two more people to help with the collection on that Sunday (First Communion) to help collect the offering and ballots; they will both be in the same collection basket. The ballots will be counted on Monday morning, April 26th.

Preparation of Rectory—The painting is done; the carpet and garage have been cleaned.

Music: Saturday and Sunday Masses need more people to help; ads in newspaper have not helped. Maybe ask old choir to come back or have Fr. Francis recruit help.

New Business: Fr. Joe Thank You—Angels will provide a Sheet Cake for coffee after the April 18th. Mass.

First Communion—Sun., April 25th. Pete will check with Anna and Jen to see if they if they need help.

Welcome Fr. Francis Potluck—June 6th—After the Sunday Mass. Pete will check to see if this meets Father Francis' approval.

Spring Clean Up: "Sentence to Serve" has raked and cleaned up the church grounds. The Building & Grounds committee will organize the work that should be done this spring. Suggestions: clean church-pews, etc.; change light bulbs; spray for beetles; clean windows in dining hall & classrooms; paint classrooms & handicapped parking spaces; repair lip on sidewalk & connecting parking lot space; strip and stain wood on entrance beams and front of the old church entrance.

Other Business: Need a new Church Directory; put on May agenda. UCA campaign is coming. Suggestion to have the parish and their other committees and groups discuss the donation requests, or who they have donated to, because there may be some overlapping. The Auction fundraiser is set for, Sat., September 4th.
