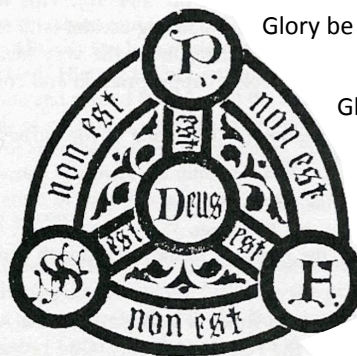

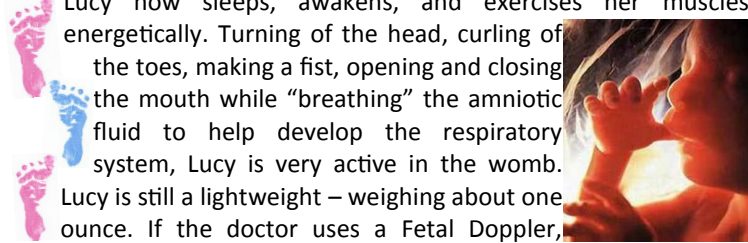

WEEK 13: FEARFULLY AND WONDERFULLY MADE

This weekly pro-life education tool will follow the development of a child in the womb beginning with Annunciation until Christmas.

Lucy now sleeps, awakens, and exercises her muscles energetically. Turning of the head, curling of the toes, making a fist, opening and closing the mouth while "breathing" the amniotic fluid to help develop the respiratory system, Lucy is very active in the womb. Lucy is still a lightweight – weighing about one ounce. If the doctor uses a Fetal Doppler, Lucy's heartbeat can be heard, which sounds like galloping horses.
