KENYAN MISSION OUTREACH

MOTO HOPE MISSION PROJECT UPDATES—NEXT STEPS

The Moto Hope Mission Committee thanks everyone who participated in the recent Moto Hope dinners at Sacred Heart and St. Agnes to learn more about Fr. Francis's Elementary School project in Kenya. While the evenings were not intended as fundraisers, parishioners gave nearly \$3,000 to help pay for the expense of the wonderful African meals prepared by chefs Guy LaFontaine and Jerry Bielke. Money left over after paying for the meals went toward the Moto Hope school project. Thanks to all the volunteers who made both evenings so special.

While actual fundraising for the Moto Hope school project has not begun in earnest, the committee reports that over \$11,000 has been received to date from parishioners and others who are excited about this outreach project. Here are the next steps in the Moto Hope fundraising effort:

- Since this year we have no missionary visiting our parishes seeking donation on their mission projects, with blessings from the parish councils, there will be a 2nd collection taken up at all Masses at both St. Agnes and Sacred Heart on the 4th of July weekend and the Labor Day weekend in September to give visitors to the area a chance, (if they choose) to contribute to the Moto Hope school project in Kenya that we have adapted.
- All parishioners at both Sacred Heart and St. Agnes will receive in the mail a special invitation to voluntary support the Moto Hope school project financially by either attending a gala fundraising dinner September on 13th at The Chase on The Lake Ballroom, or by simply returning their gift or pledge (either by mail or in the collection plate) in a special return envelope. Look for your invitation to arrive in about a month.

The mailing and dinner constitute the main fundraiser toward achieving \$50,000 by the end of the year to finance Phase One of the Moto Hope school project. The school will be built in several phases, starting as a day school but expanded later with more classrooms and boarding facilities. Bishop Sirba is supporting the project and has commended both parishes for adopting it. All work on the project is voluntary and expenses to date have been minimal. As a non-profit, the Moto Hope Mission record of income and expenses is open to anyone who wishes to review them. Again, the Moto Hope Mission Committee thanks everyone who has contributed time, talent and money to help get this important outreach project off the ground.
