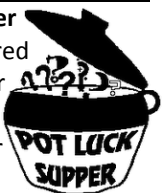

Walker's 2011 40 Days for Life Campaign will celebrate its finale on the frontlines on **Sunday, November 6, at 3 pm outside the Bemidji Planned Parenthood**. Isaiah 54:2-3 says "Enlarge the space for your tent...for you shall spread abroad to the right and to the left." While the tent is our prayer foundation, babies' lives are saved (at least 417 during this campaign in 301 cities) outside clinics where either abortions are performed or where referrals are made. Fr. Don Braukman will share his experience with pro-life ministry and Michael Latawiec, founder of "Samuel's Project" will offer his testimony and encourage participants to continue in the Lord's work.
